



Tri-State Jazz Society, formed in 1988, is dedicated to the preservation and live performance of traditional jazz. Concerts featuring leading professional soloists and bands are presented throughout the year. Events are open to the public and all who enjoy traditional jazz are invited to join. The society is a non-profit educational corporation supported by its members.

Admission Prices

General admission to band and piano concerts is \$20 unless otherwise stated. Non-members are invited to attend their first concert for half price (\$10). Members pay half price at all regular concerts. High school and college students with school identification are admitted free to all concerts. Younger children with a paying adult are also free.

Membership

Dues are \$20 per person. All memberships run from July 1 to June 30, but new members who join between March 1 and June 30 of any year will have their memberships extended until June 30 of the following year. New members are admitted free to the concert at which they join. In addition to half-price admission to all regular concerts, members receive *The Strutter* newsletter. Premium memberships help sustain and expand the work of Tri-State Jazz Society. Individual Sponsors contribute at the \$50 level (\$70 for couples). Patron level starts at \$100 (\$120 for couples). Dues and contributions may be tax deductible.
