PHILADELPHIA – One of Philadelphia's premier keyboardists, Dave Posmontier brings his Dixie Kings septet featuring New Orleans-style traditional jazz to Community Arts Center, 414 Plush Mill Road, Wallingford, PA, on Sunday, January 7th, at 2:00 p.m. for a Tri-State Jazz Society performance. The band includes many of the same local musicians who were members of the well-respected Ed Wise Jazz Band under bassist Ed Wise. Members have also played, backed up or recorded with the Glenn Miller Orchestra, Frank Sinatra, Liza Minnelli, Nancy Wilson, Tony Bennett, Johnny Mathis, George Benson and Arthur Prysock to name a few. Band members are very active on the Philadelphia music scene too performing with Peter Nero's Philly Pops, the Pennsylvania Ballet Orchestra, the Delaware Symphony Orchestra and the Philadelphia Orchestra.

Half-price admission of \$10, payable at the door, is available for first-time attendees and members; general admission is \$20; full-time students with IDs and children are free. There are no advance sales or reservations. The Arts Center is less than a mile from the Media-Swarthmore exit of I-476 (the "Blue Route") and has free parking.
